Applicants can apply directly on our website at [dunhamslawncarellc.com](http://dunhamslawncarellc.com) or by emailing us their completed application form. The application form should include the following:

- Applicant's name and contact information (phone number, email address, and property address).
- Name of the nonprofit organization or individual being nominated (if applicable).
- A short essay (up to 500 words) explaining why the applicant or nominee deserves to receive the donated landscaping project. The essay should highlight the impact of the project on the community or individual's life.
- Photos or other supporting documentation that showcase the organization or individual in need of landscaping that may support your nomination.

Our selection committee will review all applications based on criteria such as:

- Impact of the landscaping project on the community or individual.
- Creativity and innovation in the proposed project.
- Feasibility of the project within the \$1,000 budget.
- The winner will be announced in July and notified via email or phone.
- Project to be scheduled as determined by Dunham's Lawn Care.

**Project Implementation:** The landscaping work will be scheduled and completed, as agreed upon between the winner and Dunham's Lawn Care. Our team will provide all necessary materials and labor for the project within the \$1,000 budget.
